

Action Plan

Legislative

- House Bill 208, “An Act Providing for a Free, Comprehensive, and Progressive National Public Health Care System” filed by Alliance of Concerned Teachers Partylist, Kabataan Partylist, and Gabriela Women’s Partylist, plus 24 other related bills on health services provision
- Formation of health workers’ partylist to promote health and ensure representation in congress

Community-based health programs (CBHPs)

- Basic health skills training of community health workers
 - Expansion areas: Diocese of Novaliches; Pinagbuhatan, Pasig
 - New areas: Dasmarinas, Cavite
- Following up, monitoring, and revitalization of other CBHPs
 - Priority areas: Negros Island Health Integrated Program for Community Development (NIHIPCD)

Information and education campaigns

- Education campaigns and release of educational materials on failure of Philhealth (national health insurance system) and impact of privatization on health service delivery

Research

- Paths to nationalize health care
- Effect of underinvestment in health on health workers and health service delivery
- Occupational health and safety



Action Plan

Expansion and maintenance of networks

- Local: organizations on governance, consumer rights, human rights (Karapatan, Gabriela)
- International:

- Engagement with local government units: Pasig City

Monitoring of compliance to recommendations by UN Periodic Review

Mass movements

- Demands for release of One COVID-19 Allowance for frontline health workers

- Negros Oriental: militarized area with multiple reports of human rights violations and media blackout
